8th Symposium of CIEC: "Fertilizers and Environment"
 Salamanca, Spain, 26-29 September, 1994

The Symposium, organized by CIEC jointly with the host institution the Instituto de Recursos Naturales y Agrobiología of the Spanish Council for Scientific Research and the University of Salamanca, will bring together scientists in diverse research topics dealing with fertilizer application to crops and its impact on the environment.

The topics of the Symposium include:

- Present situation of fertilizer production and use in the world, outlooks.
- Importance and benefits of fertilizer application for food and forestal production: Situation in developed, reforming (East Europe) and developing countries with respect to sustainable agriculture.
- Mineral fertilizers and organic manures from plant and animal production, urban and industrial wastes.
- Mineral fertilizers and organic manures in a nutrient cycling concept with respect to sustaining or increasing soil fertility (soil reserves, release, immobilization, interactions with soil organic matter, etc.).
